Accepted abstracts and articles should be submitted in accordance with the scientific rules and publishing policy indicated on the Journal of the Faculty of Home Economics website (https://mkas.journals.ekb.eg). The research or its abstract must not have been published in any conferences, journals, bulletins, or scientific periodicals.

The abstract and research must be written in Microsoft Word and formatted according to the requirements stated in the conference link. The number of manuscript pages should be limited to ten (depending on the journal template for publishing), with each additional page charging an additional price. The scientific committee will examine research abstracts and submissions for publishing at the conference, and accepted material will appear in the April issue of the faculty journal. The conference website will include information about the conference's activities and publications.

# Deadlines for Abstracts and Articles Submission.

The deadline for abstracts submission is December 31, 2023.

The deadline for submitting accepted papers for publication is February 15, 2024.

The abstract should be at least 150 words and at most 250 words long, and 3-5 keywords should accompany it.

- 4- Listener or accompanying person with accommodation and round-trip transportation: 3500 EGP for Egyptians and 300 US dollars for non-Egyptians.
- 5- Presenting a research paper or poster and publishing the abstract with accommodation and round-trip transportation: 4500 EGP for Egyptians and 400 US dollars for non-Egyptians.
- 6- Presenting a research paper and its publication with accommodation and roundtrip transportation: 4600 EGP for Egyptians and 500 US dollars for non-Egyptians, provided that the number of pages is at most ten in the journal format. For each additional

page, an extra 30 Egyptian pounds will be charged for Egyptians and 5 US dollars for non-Egyptians.

- 7- Company delegations, with a maximum of 3 individuals: 900 EGP for Egyptians and 300 US dollars for non-Egyptians without accommodation.
- 8- Participation in the exhibition: 1000 EGP per meter square for Egyptians and 100 US dollars for non-Egyptians without accommodation.
